Our next CI Music Hour will be July 15th with Uncle Henry's Favorites! Uncle Henry's Favorites is our very own Ellen Vigour's old-time string band with her husband, Pete.

Pete and Ellen Vigour have been residents of Albemarle County, Virginia, for over forty years, spending most of their spare time playing traditional Appalachian music. Their repertoire features old-time fiddle tunes and songs, many learned from older players from their local area. Ellen, recently retired from her career as a special education teacher, is a caller for square dances, and also likes to repair old violins rescued from yard sales and antique stores. Pete teaches fiddle, guitar, banjo, mandolin, and other instruments at the Front Porch music school in Charlottesville, VA.

Sixty years ago, at the age of 5, Ellen developed a serious case of the mumps, leaving her with single-sided deafness. Despite the challenges, she grew up with a love for music. As an adult, the high frequencies in her only hearing ear declined significantly. Getting a cochlear implant two years ago has greatly improved her speech understanding. Together, Pete and Ellen work to improve her pitch recognition for music, as the CI presents challenges as well as improvements in her hearing.
