"I'm Tom Tucker living in Los Angeles. I have a very severe hearing loss in the high frequencies in both ears since birth. I wear hearing aids in both ears. I sing and play the piano. I can't hear the sounds "S", "SH", "T", "P" and a couple of others, without hearing aids. Also I can't hear the last two octaves on the piano without hearing aids. My hearing aids do help, but don't restore everything. My speech is not perfect and I have taken lots of speech therapy when younger.

Singing has always been a challenge for me. I had a wonderful vocal teacher for ten years that understood my hearing loss. He really helped me to develop my voice. I also experimented a lot on my own to improve it. I'm a spinto lyric tenor and sing classical including opera arias, pop, r&b and theater."
