Theresa Welbourne is an Affiliated Research Professor at the Center for Effective Organizations (CEO) in the Marshall School of Business, University of Southern California. She is also is the Will and Maggie Brooke Professor in Entrepreneurship Institute at The University of Alabama. In addition, Theresa is the founder, President and CEO of eePulse, a company in the

HR technology business that has led the charge to transform surveys into leadership tools.

Dr. Welbourne's work focuses on human capital and leadership strategies that drive growth, innovation and high performance. She is known for her work on employee energy and how energy, direction and confidence come together to stimulate and sustain high sense of urgency cultures and organizational growth. Theresa does extensive research and consulting with initial public offerings (IPOs) and firms undergoing high change, including mergers and acquisitions. Other areas of expertise include employee engagement, data-driven story telling, Fast HR and entrepreneurship.

She also established and manages the Leadership Pulse (www.leadershippulse.com), which connects leaders using a data-driven approach to learning. Lastly, she teaches data-driven storytelling, which is a skill used by numerous leaders, workforce analytics groups and entrepreneurs to drive higher performance.
