WHAT SETS US APART?

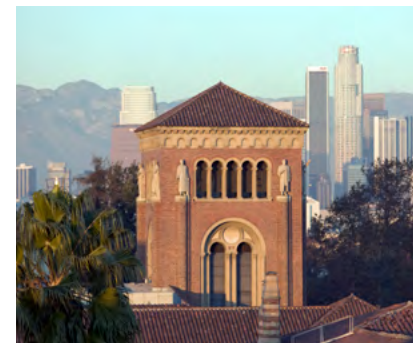
