### Unhoused Women in Los Angeles


"The prevalence of violence is the biggest difference between men's and women's experiences of homelessness in Los Angeles.

For many women, violence is not a single instance but an ingoing reality that is further exacerbated by the experience of homelessness itself. Of the women surveyed..., more than 60% had experienced violence at some point in the last 12 months, and 25.7% reported the violence as occurring constantly or often."





#### Homelessness + Housing

\$2,230 per month, up from \$2,180 in 2018. Los Angeles County registered the highest county-level average rent in Southern California in 2019, continuing a trend going back at least to the start of the decade. The average rent increased 2.3% year over year. The rents are projected to further increase into 2021, with 52.7% of the population already suffering rent burden.

The rent market cannot continue to increase, with housing as the number one needed resource among the unhoused population. There needs to be a cost-effective way for the unhoused to get a safe and peaceful night's rest.






